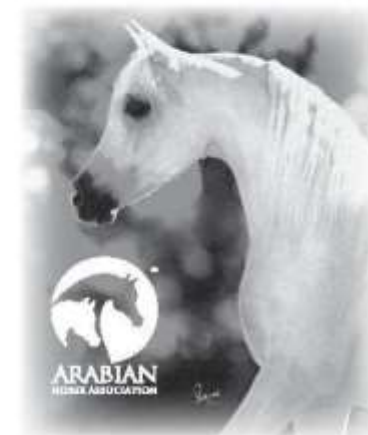

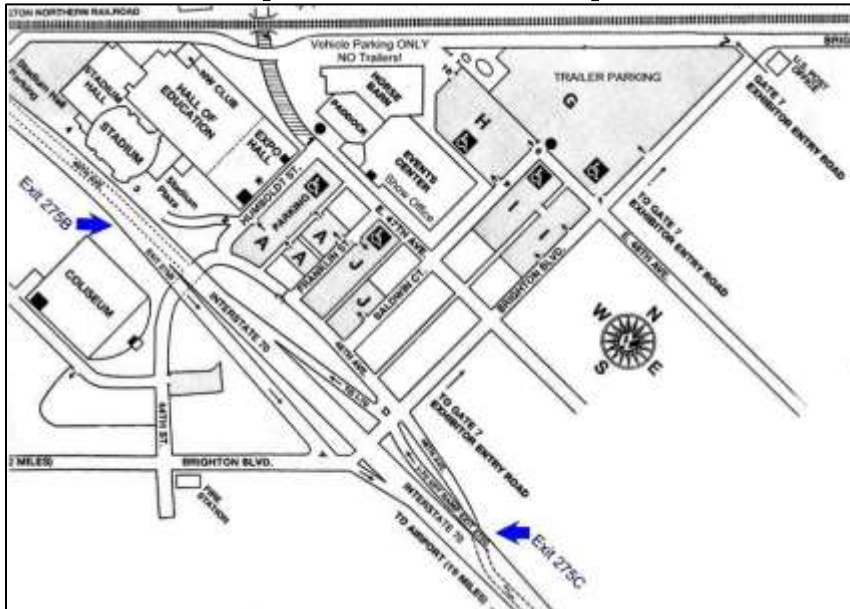

RULES AND REGULATIONS: Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF Rule Book will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith. Class Specifications are covered in the AHA handbook and the USEF rulebook.

AHA MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT: EACH COMPETITOR (THIS INCLUDES AT LEAST ONE RECORDED OWNER AND ALL TRAINERS, DRIVERS, RIDERS, HALTER HANDLERS, COACHES AND THE PERSON(S) SIGNING THE ENTRY BLANK) IN AN ARABIAN HORSE ASSOCIATION RECOGNIZED ARABIAN DIVISION, AT THE TIME OF ENTRY INTO A COMPETITION, MUST SUBMIT A COPY OF A VALID AHA MEMBERSHIP/COMPETITION CARD, JOIN AHA OR PAY AN AHA SINGLE EVENT MEMBERSHIP FEE PER COMPETITOR. WHEN AN AGENT SIGNS FOR THE OWNER AT AN AHA RECOGNIZED COMPETITION, BOTH THE OWNER AND AGENT MUST BE MEMBERS OF AHA OR PAY THE AHA SINGLE EVENT MEMBERSHIP. SINGLE EVENT MEMBERSHIP IS NOT ACCEPTABLE AT AHA REGIONAL OR NATIONAL COMPETITIONS. EXHIBITORS IN WALK-TROT CLASSES ARE EXEMPT FROM AHA MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS AT QUALIFYING COMPETITIONS, BUT MUST HAVE AN AHA MEMBERSHIP WITH COMPETITION CARD AT AHA REGIONAL AND NATIONAL COMPETITIONS. EXHIBITORS IN LEAD LINE CLASSES OR PARENTS/GUARDIANS SIGNING FOR MINORS ARE EXEMPT FROM AHA MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS.

Please see the reverse side of the entry blank for the Agreement and Waiver for AHA (Arabian Horse Association) members. If an owner, trainer, handler, rider or driver does not have proof of current AHA membership, s/he may join AHA at the show.

AHA MEMBERSHIP: All non-members horses entered in the show must pay a single event membership fee of \$30.00 per person. Single Event Members shall only have exhibiting privileges for the duration of the event where the membership is purchased. Any owner, trainer, driver, rider or handler who exhibits horses in the show ring or signs the entry form as the responsible person for any individuals or horses at the show, must be a COMPETITION member of AHA or pay a single event fee of \$35.00 per person. (Exception: Exhibitors entered in Walk/Trot classes and Leadline shall be exempt from paying the AHA non-member fees). Associate Cards DO NOT allow for competition privileges. Membership must include a valid COMPETITION card. Or pay the \$35.00 single event fee.

AHA SPRING SHOW 2017 CONCURRENT SHOW: The 2017 CAHC Spring Show will be held as a concurrent show. Each Arabian/Half Arabian class will be judged by two judges and scored individually by each judge.

AHA WORKING HUNTER CHAMPIONSHIPS: Per AHA rules, this prize list is required to indicate if the show is holding Working Hunter Championships. The CAHC Spring Show is not holding Working Hunter Championships.

AMATEUR OWNERS: All Adult Amateur Owners must have in their possession a current USEF Amateur Card, or must make application for such a card at least one hour prior to riding in AOTR and AAO TR classes. See USEF rule book. Applications may be secured from the Show Secretary. Leased horses may not be shown in AAO TR, AOTR & JOTR classes.

AMATEUR OWNERS (continued): Combined ownership is NOT permitted in Amateur Owner classes unless all owners are members of the same family. See USEF rule book. The horses shown in Amateur Owner classes (AAOTR, AOTR and JOTR) must be owned by the rider or his/her immediate family. See USEF rule book for definition of family.

All AAOTR, AATR, AOTR, ATR, JOTR, and JTR classes may be split by appropriate age group should entries warrant. The CAHC Spring Show committee and management recognize the need and desire for individuals to get regional qualifications.

At the same time there is a desire to balance that with maintaining a level of competition given a decrease in the number of horses at our shows in recent years.

AMATEUR CERTIFICATION: Every person who has reached his/her 18th birthday and competes in classes for amateurs under Federation rules must possess current amateur status issued by the Federation. This status must be available for inspection or the competitor must have lodged with the competition secretary, at least one hour prior to such class, an application for such status provided by the Federation. Amateur status will be issued only on receipt of the application properly signed and is revocable at any time for cause. Any person who has not reached his/her 18th birthday is an amateur and does not require amateur status.

ARENA INFORMATION: Events Center main arena is 150' x 300'; Events Center paddock arena is 85' x 185'; Stadium arena is 90' x 190'. Footing in all arenas is composed of 60% sand and 40% non-fat soluble clay.

CAMPERS/RVs: Only electric hookups are available at \$30.00 per night. Limited availability, no advance reservations.

COGGINS TEST AND HEALTH CERTIFICATE: Colorado requires a Negative Coggins test dated no more than one (1) year from date of arrival, and a Health Certificate dated no more than thirty (30) days from the date of arrival on all out of state horses.

CONCESSIONS: Will be available on the show grounds.

CREDIT CARDS: With rising costs of our shows and the decline in number of horses, we can no longer take credit cards without charging the fees CAHC incurs when processing these payments. These fees will be a percentage of the total fees and may vary depending on the rate we are charged.

FARRIER: As a courtesy to the exhibitors, the official show farrier will be available on the grounds. See show office for more information.

CRUELTY TO OR ABUSE OF A HORSE: Cruelty by any person at a recognized competition is forbidden, and constitutes a violation, and renders the offender subject to penalty. The Show Committee must bar violators from further participation for the remainder of the competition. It is the duty of the competition officials and any properly constituted humane organization to report to the Federation any person who indulges in this practice for such further action as may be deemed appropriate. The Show Committee may appoint a veterinarian to inspect any animal in the competition. Refusal to submit any animal for examination by an authorized veterinarian after due notification shall constitute a violation.

DOGS: Per National Western Contract, dogs will not be allowed in the National Western Complex. It is strongly recommended that they be left at home.

DRIVER'S LICENSE STATEMENT: Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent(s), legal guardian(s), or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Chapter 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

ENTRIES: Entries will be date stamped and a back number will be assigned each horse at the time the entry is received. Any horse that is exhibited under any back number other than the official back number assigned by the Show Secretary will be disqualified and any earned prizes will be forfeited. No refunds for scratched classes. A copy of both sides of the horse's registration papers, as well as copies of USEF and AHA membership Competition cards must accompany all entries for all riders, drivers, handlers, owners and trainers. If rider, driver, handler is a minor, it is mandatory that the parent or guardian must sign. No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by a check, money order or Visa/MasterCard number with expiration date for the amount of the total show fees. Show tabs will be accepted on fully paid pre-entries only. A signed blank check made payable to CAHC or a Visa/MasterCard number with expiration date must be left with the Show Secretary. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to supply COMPLETE information on entry blanks. Entry blanks containing illegible or omitted information will not be processed until correct information is supplied and may be returned to exhibitor.

No entry fees will be refunded if the show cannot open or be completed by reason of terrorism, riots, civil disturbances, fire, act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, strikes, and/or other causes beyond the control of the Colorado Arabian Horse Club.

All classes with exhibitors will be held, however, Junior Exhibitor classes may be combined with other age groups if there is less than 3 exhibitors in the class. Classes may be divided if the numbers warrant this

FEDERATION FEE: For every horse participating in any competition licensed by the Federation, a \$16 Federation fee will be collected (\$8 shall be an Equine Drugs and Medication fee to provide for research, inspection, and enforcement of rules regarding use of medications and drugs; see GR407.1, .2 and .3). Exception: Horses entered in classes exempted from the Equine Drugs and Medication fee are also exempt from the balance of the Federation fee.

REFUSAL OF ENTRIES: (GR 914) In addition to entries of persons suspended or expelled from the Federation, a Licensed Competition may refuse any entry of an exhibitor or the participation of any agent, trainer, rider, driver, or handler who has shown an objectionable attitude or behaviors at a Licensed Competition or towards its management, which management is able to substantiate, or previous unsportsmanlike behaviors at a Licensed Competition which management is able to substantiate.

EXCESSIVE USE OF THE WHIP: Excessive use of a whip on any horse in a stall, runway, schooling area, show ring or elsewhere on the competition grounds before or during a competition, by any person, constitutes a violation and renders the offender subject to penalty. See Current USEF Rule Book.

FEED AND BEDDING: To provide exhibitors with the best quality at a reasonable cost, arrangements have been made for feed/shavings to be available at regular competitive prices and delivered to stalls. All feed and bedding may be purchased from the official vendor on site, B&T Feed, 303-809-6352 (cell).

FEDERATION CLASSES

A USEF Saddle Seat Medal class is offered.

FEDERATION ENTRY AGREEMENT: I have read the United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. (the "Federation") Entry Agreement (GR906.4) as printed in the Prize List for [insert name here] ("Competition") and agree to all of its provisions. I understand and agree that by entering this Competition, I am subject to Federation Rules, the Prize List, and local rules of the competition. I agree to waive the right to the use of my photos from the competition, and agree that any actions against the Federation must be brought in New York State. The complete statement is as follows:

FEDERATION ENTRY AGREEMENT

By entering a Federation-licensed Competition and signing this entry blank as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Vaultor or Longeur and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rules of The United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. (the "Federation") and the local rules of the competition.

I agree to be bound by the Bylaws and Rules of the Federation and of the competition. I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, the Federation, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the Rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Federation and/or the Competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cablecasts, broadcasts, internet, film, new media or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition, sport, or the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. The construction and application of Federation rules are governed by the laws of the State of New York, and any action instituted against the Federation must be filed in New York State. See GR908.4.

FEDERATION STATEMENT: Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Preliminary Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$30 Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot (exception: Friesian performance FR218) and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

FIRST AID: First aid treatment will be available during all performances for the duration of the horse show in accordance with USEF rules.

IN-GATE: The in-gate must and will be closed two (2) minutes after the first horse enters the ring in any class where horses are shown collectively. If an exhibitor needs a tack change, please notify the Paddock Master two (2) classes in advance. If the schedule permits and a tack change is awarded, the in-gate will remain closed a maximum of three (3) minutes. At the completion of three (3) minutes, the in-gate will be opened and the two (2) minute clock will start. Exhibitors are asked to have their next tack change readily available to the paddock area so the show can continue to run in a timely manner.

JUDGE SUBSTITUTION: In case of the illness of a Judge or the inability of a Judge to attend or perform his/her duties, the Show Committee reserves the right to substitute a Judge for the one who is officially designated in the premium list, pursuant to Current USEF Rules.

JUDGES DECISIONS ARE FINAL: Any exhibitor wishing to approach a judge regarding a decision must make an appointment by contacting the USEF Steward or the Show Committee. A show official must be present during the review. Any protest must be made in accordance with USEF rules governing protests.

JUDGING SYSTEM: There will be no particular three-judge system to be used. The one-judge system will be used for all divisions.

JUNIOR HORSE: A Horse which is 5 years or under as of January 1, 2014.

MAIDEN, NOVICE AND LIMIT RIDER/HORSE: A rider who has not won one (1); three (3); six (6) first place ribbons (respectively) at an "A" rated Arabian Division Competition as of the close of entries. See USEF rule book. GR 135

Note: A rider who begins a USEF Show season eligible to compete in these classes may continue to compete in them through that competition year regardless of winnings during the year. Eligibility is determined by the winnings of the rider, not the horse.

LEADLINE: Open to riders who are at least two (2) years of age and have not reached their ninth (9) birthday as of December 1st. Leaders must be at least fourteen (14) years of age. The safety of all exhibitors must be of primary consideration when conducting these classes. Any action by any exhibitor, leader, or horse that endangers that exhibitor or any other exhibitor or leader must be penalized and will be considered as cause for elimination. Safety is of the utmost importance in tack and attire: (a) saddle must fit rider; (b) riders' feet must be engaged in the stirrups/irons; (c) saddles may be equipped with hooded stirrups or breakaway irons; (d) leading rein must be attached to a cavesson or a halter placed under or over the bridle (Res. 21.05); (e) safety helmets, with chin straps, may be used by any rider, regardless of style of tack and/or attire; (f) boots, long pants and long sleeved shirts are required. (Res. 34-99). There shall be only one rider on each horse entered. Stallions are prohibited. This class should not be placed and similar awards should be presented to all exhibitors.

MEASUREMENTS: USEF requires that the prize list must include the time period when the on-call veterinarian will be available to conduct measurements. Because there are no classes held at the CAHC Spring Show that require height measurements, a time period for conducting measurements by an on-call veterinarian has not been scheduled.

ORDERS OF GO: Will be drawn for Reining, Trail, Showmanship and all other classes that need an order of go. Order of Go will be done no less than one hour prior to designated class and will comply with all USEF, AHA. Rules.

PADDOCK ARENA: During the show and at the discretion of the Show Management, the warm-up arena will be restricted to riders/horses who are within two (2) classes of entering the show ring. Longeing of horses will not be permitted in the warm-up arena while classes are in session. The warm-up arena will be under the strict control of the Paddock Master.

PRIZE LIST: This prize list is based on the rules of the current USEF Rule Book, and the Handbook of the Arabian Horse Association. Where they apply respectively, any changes or corrections of the rules will automatically become part of this prize list. The Show Committee shall decide questions not covered by USEF or AHA rules and its decision is final.

PUBLIC ADDRESS SYSTEM: Is considered a courtesy to the exhibitors and its function or coverage to all areas cannot be guaranteed. No protests will be upheld, or refunds made, solely because of sound system inadequacy or failure. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to be aware of the show's progress and be ready for their classes.

PROTECTIVE HEADGEAR: Except as may otherwise be mandated by local law, the Federation strongly encourages all riders, while riding anywhere on the competition grounds, to wear protective headgear with harness secured which passes or surpasses ASTM (American Society for Testing and Materials)/SEI (Safety Equipment Institute) standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag. (Exception hunter, jumper, or hunter/jumper competitions refer to GR801.2) It is the responsibility of the rider, or the parent or guardian or trainer of the junior exhibitor to see to it that the headgear worn complies with appropriate safety standards for protective headgear intended for equestrian use, and is properly fitted and in good condition, and the Federation, Show Committee, and Licensed Officials are not responsible for checking headgear worn for such compliance. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

AWARDS: Regular classes: Ribbons through 6th; Champion: Ribbons through 8th with gift certificate to Show Me Twice to Champion. Donations accepted to be given to regular classes and championship classes. Jackpot = 70% to 1st and 30% to 2nd.

TRAINING TACK CLASSES: Local rule classes, conducted under the Arabian division rule for each division. Where training attire and training tack are allowed, riders must have boots with heels. Safety of the horse and rider is paramount. Horses must not interfere with other riders in the class. Training tack classes are not AHA classes and will be judged by only one judge.

UPHA CHALLENGE CUP CLASSES: These equitation classes are open to all breeds.

VETERINARIAN: A Veterinarian will be on call during all sessions of the horse show. Charges for medication and/or treatment shall be paid directly to the veterinarian. Show management reserves the right to request the veterinarian to examine, at the owner's expense, any horse visibly ill or injured, and if the veterinarian determines that such horse is potentially communicable, the horse will be required to be removed from the show grounds immediately. In such an instance, vet outs will be honored.

VET OUTS: All vet certificates must be in the show office by the end of the show.

REFUNDS/VETOUTS: Will be mailed out within thirty (30) days after the close of the Show.

SELECT RIDER: Please refer to USEF Rule AR110.2 for full specification.

SECURITY: Exhibitors are advised that it is their responsibility to secure valuables and their stall areas. The Colorado Arabian Horse Club and the Arabian Horse Association, its members, agents, employees and volunteers accept no responsibility for losses sustained or caused by any exhibitor.

SPECIAL NOTICE: The Colorado Arabian Horse Club Board of Directors has mandated that entries must be refused from any individual or any entry that has an outstanding obligation to the Colorado Arabian Horse Club, its Affiliates, or any of its Shows.

STALLING: All stalls are box stalls with full doors. Stalls will be assigned as entries are received. To be stalled with a trainer or as a group, all entries must be mailed together in the same envelope. Feed and bedding will be available on the grounds prior to the show. All feed and bedding may be purchased from the official vendor on site, B&T Feed, 303-809-6352 (cell).

STALLING INFORMATION: Stalls will be available at 8:00 AM on Thursday May 25, 2017. Stalls must be vacated by 8:00 AM. Monday May 29. Stalls will be assigned as entries are received, except for patrons who will receive priority stalling if entries are postmarked by April 28, 2017. To be stalled with a trainer or as a group, all entries must be mailed together in the same envelope. No bedding will be provided. Feed and bedding will be available on the grounds starting at 8:00 AM. Wednesday May 24. Stalls must be prepaid or assignments will not be made. For early arrivals, prior to Thursday May 25, 8:00 AM, you must contact Bill Amen, barn manager, 303-809-6352. There will be an early arrival fee of \$35.00, per horse, per stall. Special arrangements for stalling before Wednesday May 24 may be available and will be charged at a rate to cover stalls and security. There is a \$15.00 fee for stall panels not replaced in their original positions with pins in place.

TBA (TO BE ANNOUNCED) CLASSES: Any class on the AHA Class Code List that is recognized by AHA, with the exception of classes that would require a specialty judge or equipment. i.e., Jumps, Dressage, Sport Horse etc. can be requested. Open classes may be requested as well. The fee will be \$35.00 per class for any class requested to be run in the T B A. class slots or where the exhibitor would like the class to be held. If we have 3 or more horses in the class, the fee will be waived.

WARM UP AND EXERCISE SCHEDULES: if applicable, will be posted in the horse show office.

WITHDRAWING ENTRIES: After the close of entries horses may be scratched from the horse show at the owner's option. HOWEVER, UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES WILL ANY FEES OR STALL/TACK STALL CHARGES BE REFUNDED TO THE OWNER.

ACADEMY DIVISION

The purpose of this division is to introduce new clients to the joys of showing by giving beginning riders with horses of any breed an opportunity to gain experience by offering classes within an A show. Riders only are judged. Riding suits and chaps are not allowed. Riding pants, jodhpurs, breeches, or jeans are considered appropriate. A neatly fitted shirt or top is suggested. Long sleeves are to be worn. **APPROPRIATE FOOTWEAR WITH A SMALL HEEL IS MANDATORY AS IS A HELMET FOR RIDERS. RIDERS ARE NOT ALLOWED TO CROSS ENTER INTO ANY NON-ACADEMY CLASSES.**

HORSES- It is encouraged that horses be lesson horses of any breed. All horses are welcome as long as they display good manners and a quiet disposition. **HORSES ARE NOT TO BE JUDGED.** A cutback saddle for saddle seat, a western saddle for stock seat, and a hunt saddle for hunt seat are to be used. Work bridles and bits, including snaffles, are allowed and running martingales are permitted and encouraged. However, tie down martingales are prohibited. Any horse/rider not abiding by these rules will be eliminated from academy division by management. All Academy classes are to be judged on the ability of the rider to control and show their horse to its best advantage judged on the rider's basic skills and the equitation shown. Correct diagonals and leads will be considered. Riders should convey the impression of good posture, balance and effective control as well as show ring placement.

ENTRY FEE FOR DIVISION: \$150.00 PER HORSE including stall. Horse **may not** be entered in any other division, and **may carry multiple riders.** If horses are entered in other divisions, regular entry fees for classes and regular stall fees apply and each Academy class will be \$20 per class.
